I. Weekend Trips:

Weekend trips are all-day excursions to local shopping complexes on Fridays, and to cultural and leisure locations both in Dubai, and in other cities and regions of the United Arab Emirates including Sharjah, Al-Ain, Fujairah and Khor Fakkan on Saturdays. These trips are all undertaken under careful supervision to ensure the safety of our students. Transportation costs and entrance fees where necessary are included in the tuition fees.

K. Boarding Facilities:

- Boarding facilities are available for students aged 10 years to 17 years old.
- Rooms are arranged in a centrally supervised single-sex dormitory structure.
- Students are grouped in dorms/rooms first by age, then according to common classes/interests.
- Individual dorms are monitored around the clock by live-in Third Parents™ who are available to students 24 hours a day. Dorm regulations will apply.
- The dorm's laundromat is accessible once a week for washing and ironing.
- Students will be required to mark their clothes with a unique student number that will be allocated upon registration.
- Students attending our boarding programs will be served three meals daily. A set menu for each meal has been selected that considers the diverse and international nature of the student community. All menus will rotate on a ten-day basis.

Applicants that have friends or relatives in the UAE and would like to spend the weekend with them may do so subject to pre-approval by parents. A written request should be submitted by the hosts at least three days before the start of the required weekend. All students should return by 06.00 pm on Saturday at the latest.

- a) 50% of the Total Fees are payable at the time of registration, while the second installment is payable latest by **December 01 of every academic year**. Total Fees are calculated until the end of the academic year which ends June 30 of every academic year, and include:

 - ii. Optional upgrade: Single room instead of double room additional **AED38,500/- +VAT**
 - iii. Optional upgrade: Football fees amounting to **AED44,500/- +VAT**
 - iv. Pocket Money Deposit as decided by the parents as per **Section L** of this application form.
 - v. Telephone Deposit as decided by the parents as per **Section M** of this application form.
 - vi. Additional Activities for selections made by the parents/guardians as outlined in **Section J** of this form are payable at the time of registration.
 - vii. VAT is charged on Total Fees in keeping with current UAE taxation laws.
